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## EXECUTION SUMMARY

The implementation of the Ramadan 2026 activity took place without any major incidents. It consisted of ordering food supplies in accordance with the recommended quantities, following the request of our partner organization Yeryüzü Doktorları, which were then stored in our warehouses.

First, we repackaged the items into kits containing 15 kg of rice, 2 kg of sugar, 1.8 liters of oil, 400 grams of tomato paste, and 0.5 kg of dates, commonly called "tamarou" in Burkina Faso.

After that, we prepared a total of 200 food parcels. The distribution took place in a province of Burkina Faso called Loroum, located 230 km from the capital, whose provincial capital is Titao.

This town, which had been under blockade by armed terrorist groups from 2021 to 2026, hosts a large number of internally displaced persons.

## CRISIS CONTEXT AND FOOD NEEDS IN BURKINA FASO

Burkina Faso is currently facing a complex humanitarian crisis driven by insecurity, population displacement, climate shocks, and economic challenges. These factors have significantly increased food insecurity and humanitarian needs across the country.

Since 2015, the country has experienced growing attacks by armed groups, particularly in northern and eastern regions. The insecurity has forced millions of people to flee their homes, making Burkina Faso one of the fastest-growing displacement crises in the world. More than 2 million people have been internally displaced, many of whom have lost access to farmland, livestock, and livelihoods.

Displaced populations often settle in urban centers or safer towns where they depend largely on humanitarian assistance and host communities for survival.

Food insecurity has increased sharply in recent years. It is estimated that about 2.7 million people are facing acute food insecurity in the country, while millions more require humanitarian support.

In some conflict-affected areas, entire towns have been under blockade by armed groups, restricting the movement of goods and people. In these areas, food supplies are

extremely limited and often depend on military-escorted convoys or humanitarian deliveries.

This situation leads to:

- Shortage of basic food commodities
- High food prices
- Reduced dietary diversity for vulnerable households

During the Ramadan 2026 period, a food assistance project has been carried out for families living in poverty and facing serious difficulties in meeting their basic needs in Burkina Faso. Many families in the region struggle to access sufficient and regular food, and these needs increase further during Ramadan. Within the scope of this project, food packages will be distributed to support the basic nutritional needs of vulnerable households. The aid program is planned to cover 200 poor families.

**BENEFICIARIES SELACTION CRITERIA**

Regarding the beneficiary selection criteria, we gave priority to families of internally displaced persons, followed by poor households. For this reason, we targeted one of the regions most affected by terrorist attacks. Among the provinces of the Yadga region, we considered Loroum to be one of the most affected. Moreover, due to the terrorist blockade since 2021, this province had not received any food assistance from our organization. The month of Ramadan is a key period for many Burkinabe families, particularly those who are internally displaced, poor and vulnerable.

**SUGGESTIONS**

The main recommendation is increase as much as possible the food assistance particularly during the Ramadan period because many families in the Burkina Faso struggle to access sufficient and regular food, and these needs increase further during Ramadan

**SUCCESS STORY (IF ANY)**

No success story to tell but we can see on the beneficiaries faces the joyful feelings and their alleviation.

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## LESSONS LEARNED

Considering the solid experience we have acquired over the past decade, we rarely encounter obstacles in the implementation of this type of activity. Our last campaign in 2025 recorded 4,170 food parcels distributed.

We have a great experience and much abilities in such projects, since we have been implementing it likes in different regions of Burkina Faso and for many years, and they were all concluded successfully
